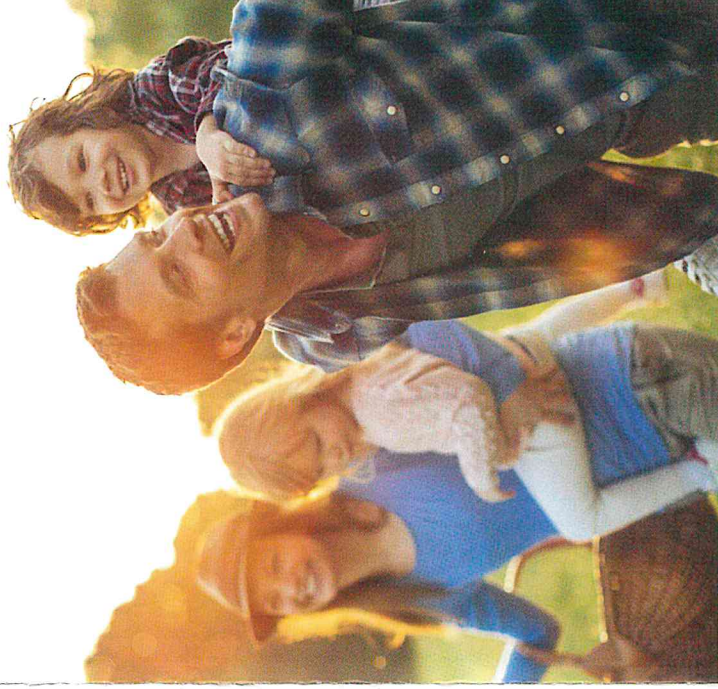

The Randy Yamada Foundation is named in honor of veteran Deputy Probation Officer Randy Yamada, whose 30-year career in the Sacramento and Santa Clara county probation departments focused on officer safety and training. Before he died in 2008, Randy had impacted thousands of law enforcement personnel statewide as a use-of-force instructor and passionate advocate for ensuring every officer would return home safely every day.

Inspired by Randy's passion for protecting peace officers and their loved ones, the Sacramento County Probation Association formed the Randy Yamada Foundation in 2013 to provide a benevolent fund for the families of fallen peace officers who were employed by the Sacramento County Probation Department. The Foundation has further expanded its purpose to include benefits for the families of fallen probation peace officers throughout California. The Randy Yamada Foundation also has the ability to provide education benefits to children of probation peace officers throughout California depending on funding accessibility.
